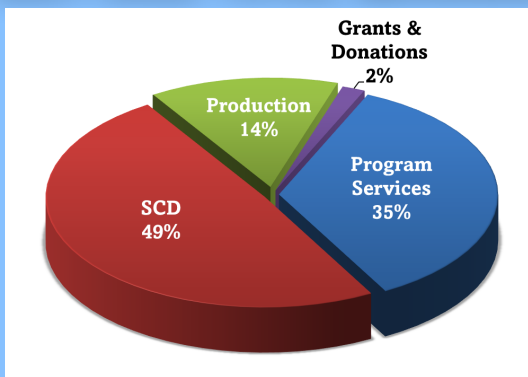

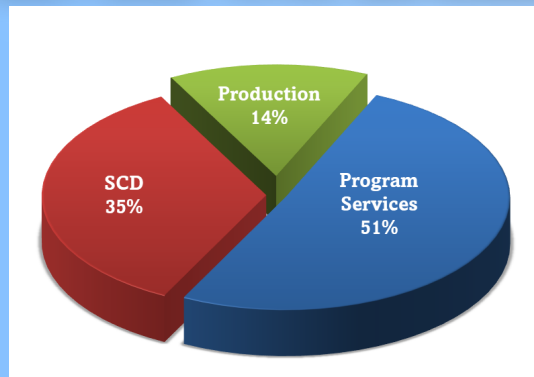

Shaquria was successful in her job but wanted help from OE to get a new job. Shaquria was in job development services for several weeks while working her part time shift at the candle company. After a few weeks of searching, the job coach helped Shaquria find employment as a kitchen staff member at a local nursing home facility. Shaquria received weekend only work hours, which is what she has always wanted to free her weekdays. She resigned from the candle company and proudly began working at the nursing home in the kitchen area. Shaquria transported herself to and from work and completed required work training through the support of OE Supported Employment services. She was recently stabilized on the jobsite to work independently with her job duties. Shaquria's supervisor says that her excellent work habits are impressive that she has requested to learn additional duties in the kitchen. The job coaches are excited to witness Shaquria's increased confidence on the job and positive work attitude because she genuinely enjoys her job.

Charlotte Air Traffic Control Tower

This year, OE started working with two new service contracts at the Air Traffic Control Tower at Fayetteville Regional Airport and the brand-new Air Traffic Control Tower in Charlotte, NC as part of the Federal Supply Schedule program with assistance from SourceAmerica. The control tower building in Fayetteville is 4,000 square feet with a tower that is four-stories tall. The control tower building in Charlotte is 40,000 square feet with a 14-story tower. That is a lot of space to clean! Staff work seven days a week and three shifts per day providing custodial services at

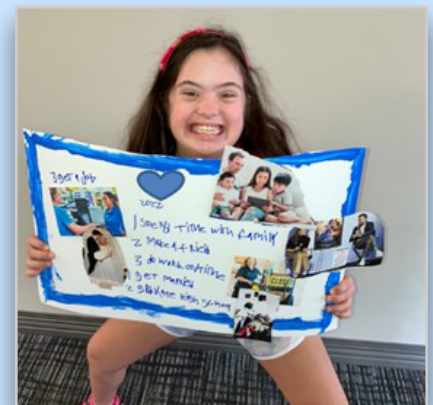
both locations. And even better, these contracts have brought more jobs to these areas for people with and without disabilities.
